CEAP Collaborative Commitment Agreement CEAP Elementary Program 2016- 2017

CEAP staff is dedicated to supporting your child's learning. It is a requirement of enrolment that the parent, student and teacher meet to review the guidelines and responsibilities listed below. All parties are expected to sign this commitment agreement.

TEACHER ROLE:

- Provide Grade Level Yearly Overview, Term Learning Plans using the BC Ministry of Education Curriculum, Core and Curricular Competencies and Outcomes, including a description of both online and print- based CEAP resources
- Offer weekly Interaction Days for social and academic growth within the CEAP Elementary community of learners
- Use a variety of current academically rich online and print- based resources and technologies, along with hands-on, play- based, and inquiry and project- based learning opportunities to support student learning
- Provide a CEAP Elementary Program monthly calendar, regular newsletters and CEAP Elementary website describing activities, classroom learning sessions, guest presenters, field trips, portfolio reviews, reporting information and timelines
- Commit to ongoing communication with students and parents through email, phone,
 Skype, tutorials, and face to face meetings
- Perform on-going diagnostic, formative and summative assessments for students, as well as regular student progress updates and reports
- o Collaborate with parents, students and families to personalize student's learning plan
- o Provide support to parents for curriculum and resource selection

PARENT ROLE

- Complete all registration forms including CEAP Elementary Commitment contract, New Student Questionnaire, Student Learning Plan, and Financial Allocations Worksheet
- Submit service provider forms and invoices, Internet reimbursement requests and any eligible receipts in a timely fashion
- Read and sign your child(ren)'s Grade Level Yearly Overview acknowledging the learning outcomes, goals and expectations
- Engage in personalizing student's curriculum with the support of the teacher(s)
- o Attend CEAP Elementary orientations, parent information and training sessions
- Engage in frequent, ongoing communication with the teacher(s), through email, phone,
 Skype, face to face meetings and portfolio reviews
- Have and use an active email address, and read, acknowledge and respond in a timely fashion to email requests; such as RSVP's, surveys, and field trip attendance
- Actively participate in your child's Learning Plan by acting as the "at-home teacher", supervising learning activities

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- Collect, organize and submit evidence of learning as requested by the teacher(s), including work samples from students, written descriptions of their activities and service provider reports
- Support and encourage students to lead the Term Portfolio Reviews
- Return all resources on loan by end of the second week in June or within one week of withdrawal from the CEAP Program

STUDENT ROLE

- o Strive to be engaged, self- motivated and self- directed learners
- Set realistic and appropriate goals for yourself
- Complete the learning assignments or inquiry based projects as outlined in your Grade Level Yearly Overview
- Contribute towards and participate in making your learning personally interesting and engaging with the support of parents, and teachers
- Complete and submit assignments and submit evidence of learning as outlined by the teacher(s)
- Attend the weekly Interaction Days, activities, learning guest presenters, and field trips, to the best of your ability
- Be prepared for Interaction Days; bringing art and school supplies as well wearing proper attire for different activities, including outdoor learning and gym - for example: Rain gear, boots and running shoes for gym
- Be a positive role model and act as a positive ambassador towards others, including classmates and the public
- Participate appropriately in all learning activities, including classroom sessions, guest speakers, and field trips
